What you will find:

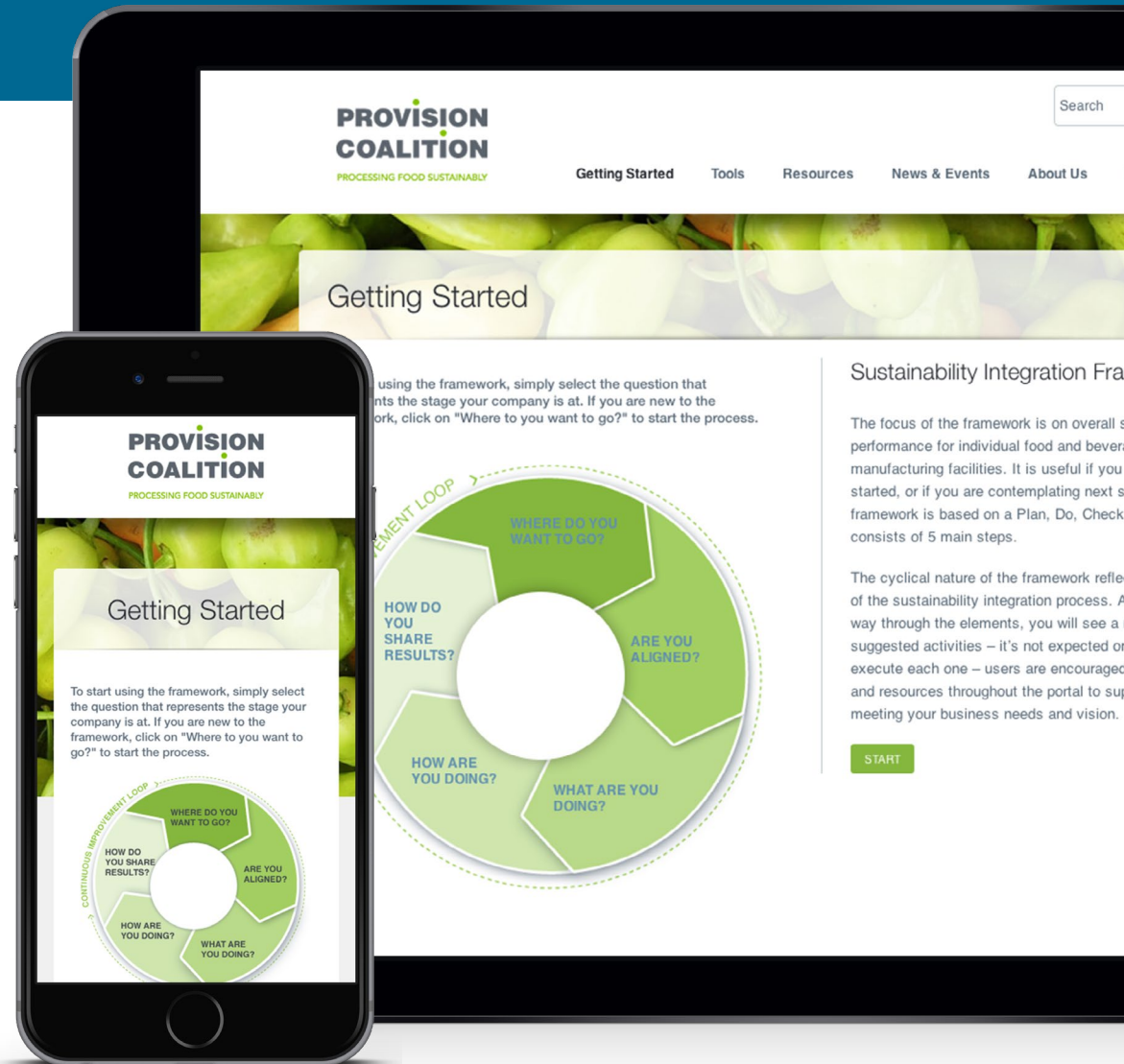
- **Getting Started Framework** to guide manufacturers on their sustainability efforts and recommended tools and resources.
